

Keyboard Shortcuts for Windows iTunes

Shortcuts to use in your music library and playlists:

Enter = Plays the selected song

Shift-Ctrl-Alt-Right Arrow = Listen to the next album in a list

Shift-Ctrl-Alt-Left Arrow = Listen to the previous album in a list

Shift-click the + button = Create a new Smart Playlist

Shift-click the Shuffle button = Reshuffle the current playlist

Ctrl-Delete = Delete the selected playlist immediately

Shift-Delete = Delete the selected playlist and all the songs listed in it

Shift-Delete = Delete the selected song from your library and all playlists

Ctrl-click the checkbox next to a song = Check or uncheck all the songs in a list

Right clicking on a column heading = Change the song information columns you see

Ctrl-click a triangle = Expand or collapse all the triangles in the Radio's Stream list

Shift-double-click the title bar = Zoom the window

F5 = Refresh the Radio or Party Shuffle list

Ctrl-Shift-Right Arrow = Next Chapter

Ctrl-Shift-Left Arrow = Previous Chapter

Shortcuts to use in the Music Store:

Ctrl-] = Next Page

Ctrl-[= Previous Page

File Menu Shortcuts:

Ctrl-N = New Playlist

Ctrl-Shift-N = New Playlist with selected songs

Ctrl-Alt-N = New Smart Playlist

Ctrl-O = Add File

Ctrl-W = Close

Ctrl-Shift-O = Import

Ctrl-I = Get Info

Ctrl-R = Show File

Ctrl-L = Show File that is currently playing

Edit Menu Shortcuts:

Ctrl-Z = Undo

Ctrl-X = Cut

Ctrl-C = Copy

Ctrl-V = Paste

Ctrl-A = Select All

Ctrl-Shift-A = Unselect All

Ctrl-B = Toggle the Artist and Album columns

Ctrl-G = Toggle song artwork

Ctrl-J = View Alts

Ctrl-comma = Preferences

Controls Menu Shortcuts:

Spacebar: Play

Spacebar: Pause

Right Arrow = Next song

Left Arrow = Previous song

Ctrl-Up Arrow = Increase volume

Ctrl-Down Arrow = Decrease volume

Ctrl-Shift-Down Arrow = Mute

Ctrl-E = Eject CD

Visualizer Menu Shortcuts

Ctrl-T = Toggle Visualizer

Ctrl-F = Toggle Visualizer full-screen

Advanced Menu Shortcuts

Ctrl-M = Mini Player

Ctrl-U = Stream audio from a URL
